



Tim Lee, the rebellious teenager and son of a Baptist minister, once walked the streets of McLeansboro, Illinois, in violent protest to all ordained authority in the home, the church, the school. He was a born fighter. He joined the Marine Corps in 1969. After his training, he received orders to serve in southeast Asia. In March of 1971, he was apprehended by the hand of God along an abandoned grassy trail in Quang Nam Province, Vietnam. In that moment, engulfed in smoke, fire and holy vengeance, a land mine explosion severed two lower limbs, and placed in a wheelchair for life a young man who was to carry, without legs, a message from God to a nation.

After his call to preach in 1973, and following a year of itinerant evangelistic preaching, Tim Lee pastored for five years in southern Illinois before surrendering to the full-time ministry of evangelism in 1979. The results in the lives of people was almost immediate as the former Marine began to stir and challenge God's people across the country. Today, people of all ages listen; among them teenagers, the professional person, United States Congressmen and Senators, Governors, Mayors and elected officials. They hear a clear, uncompromising message grounded deep in old fashioned patriotism, righteous living and biblical revival.

Rick Scarborough holds a Master of Divinity Degree from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary and a Doctor of Ministry Degree from Louisiana Baptist Theological Seminary. He graduated from Houston Baptist University, with a double major in Political Science and Speech. In 1998, he founded Vision America, an organization whose mission is to "inform and mobilize Pastors and their congregations to become salt and light, becoming proactive in restoring Judeo-Christian values in America." In 2008 he published the widely acclaimed book appropriately entitled, Enough is Enough. Other published works include, Mixing



Church and State God's Way and It All Depends on What Is...Is, and Liberalism Kills Kids.
