Dear Vision America Family,

August was a very busy and productive month. I preached in a number of churches, conducted two area-wide rallies, and recorded a total of 15 radio programs. These programs began airing August 4 and are aired daily, Monday through Friday over KJAK 92.7 FM in Lubbock, Texas. We also have finalized a commitment that will put Vision America on 30 more stations across the state, two days a week beginning this month. Church rallies in August included First Baptist Church, Houston, Birchman Baptist Church in Ft. Worth, and First Baptist Church in Katy. Area-wide rallies with multiple church participation were conducted in Stephenville and Abilene, Texas.

Each event provided fresh evidence that God is blessing our work and labors. I am finding a hunger in people for Pastors to stand up, speak up and refuse to give up whether they worship in a sophisticated megachurch like the great FBC of Houston or come from a small church like Buffalo Gap Baptist Church.

Increasingly people from all walks of life know that if the church remains silent on the crucial issues of the day we will lose our beloved America to the social engineers who have hijacked our culture.

Without question, the highlight of August was our annual Dinner and Gala, held at the Westin Galleria Hotel in Houston, Texas. More than 800 attended this outstanding celebration of Faith and Freedom. Guests included over 55 elected officials and more than 100 Pastors and their wives from a broad cross-section of faiths. The Bible tells us ...

Where there is no vision the people perish

Today, more than ever before in our history, "we need a vision in America," said Alabama Supreme Court Chief Justice Roy Moore, addressing more than 800 people of faith August 22 when he was named Vision America's 'National Hero of Faith."

But, how can we have a vision without God?

Our forefathers had a vision when they came to this land 382 years ago — a vision decribed in the Mayflower Compact, "undertaken for the Glory of God, and Advancement of the Christian Faith,"

A vision still strong 169 years later when President George Washington spoke these words in his inaugural address on April 30, 1789:

"... it would be peculiarly improper to omit in this first official Act, my fervent supplications to that Almighty Being who rules over the Universe, who presides in the Councils of Nations, and whose providential aids can supply every human defect, that His benediction may consecrate to the liberties and happiness of the People of the United States, a Government instituted by themselves for these essential purposes: and may enable every instrument employed in its administration to execute with success, the functions allotted to His charge. In tendering this homage to the *Great Author of every public and private* good I assure myself that it expresses your sentiments not less than my own; nor those of my fellow-citizens at large

Justice Moore noted several other "visions" held throughout this nation's history, including Congressional resolutions calling for "a national day of prayer."

"The first thing that Congress [Continental Congress, 1779] did was to acknowledge God," Moore said. "I believe they knew what they were writing in the Congressional Proclamation better than we know today."

"How, then, can judges and attorneys today take the First Amendment and twist it" to imply that it means America has only 'freedom FROM religion' instead of 'freedom OF religion?

Urging the audience to stand up and demand that religious freedom be reinstated in this nation, Moore said, "It is not wrong to acknowledge God under the First Amendment. It never has been, and it never will be!"

Nonetheless, he reminded listeners that giant steps are taken daily to destroy the vision of this great nation "Under God." As, indeed, there are, and have been for many years!

fought through our courts to eliminate prayer in schools, and we stood by and allowed it.

- Roe v Wade was fought in our court system, and women won the "right" to kill their unborn babies, and we stood by and allowed it.
- Crude vulgarities and pornography abound on the internet, and we allow it under the guise of "freedom of speech," while we allow public discussion of God to be suppressed in schools and in the workplace so we "won't offend" or discriminate against someone's "constitutional rights."

And the list grows day by day.

Calling for immediate action to change this downward spiral, Justice Moore quoted II Chronicles 7:14 "if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land." and II Chronicles 7:19-20 "But if you turn away and forsake My statutes and My commandments which I have set before you, and go and serve other gods, and worship them, then I will uproot them from My land which I have given them; and this house which I have sanctified for My name I will cast out of My sight, and will make it a proverb and a byword among all peoples."

"It is time that we join people like Rick Scarborough" Justice Moore said, and quit sitting still "until the steeples of our churches are taken down."

"How long will we sit back and allow them to take away the knowledge of God? It is time for Christians to take a stand.

"I tell you, we must fight!"

HR 2357 and S2886 ... this muzzle can be removed. It is time for YOU to act today!

Both bills are important, but HR 2357, introduced and sponsored by Congressman Walter Jones of North Carolina, will be moving through critical stages of the legislative process during the very immediate future.
